

Two Hens in the Back Yard for Each Person in the House Will Keep a Family In Fresh Eggs

VEN the smallest back yard has room for a flock large enough to supply the house with eggs. The cost of maintaining such a flock is small. Table and kitchen waste pro-vide much of the feed for the hens. They require little attention only a few minutes a day.
