Following are the concerns that we, as residents and property owners in the neighbourhood, have regarding this project. Building the towers would be against the urban planning of Ville-Marie neighbourhood, namely violating the urban density coefficient from allowed 6 to suggested 9, as well as violating the authorized height from allowed 65m to suggested 120m.

- The urban density would significantly increase which in turn would worsen traffic congestion on de la Montagne and surrounding streets
- The height of towers would change the landscape view of the city to worse

Green park space is what is missing in this neighbourhood, instead of 2 big towers.

Therefore, we suggest that the city of Montreal does NOT allow the changes to the urban plans of the neighbourhood.
